NEW CONTRACT WITH RENAULT

Centurion Electronics plc ("Centurion" or the "Company"), a leading supplier of in-car audio-visual entertainment to the European OEM market, today announces it has been selected to develop and supply a unique product to Renault's Accessories Division.

Known as the *integrated i-pod holder*, the product will allow consumers to fit their own i-Pods into an in-vehicle mounting holder, in much the same way as mobile phones are fitted. Music can then be played through the vehicles stereo system with i-Pod menu navigation being available via the steering wheel controls or the stereo's control system.

The system has been completely designed and engineered in-house by Centurion and a strategic partner. The system, due for deliveries later this month, will be launched initially across four vehicles; Modus, Clio, Espace and Laguna with a further roll-out across the entire range. Sales of the system will be across Europe and available via Renault dealerships as an accessory.

Chris Rhodes, Chief Executive of Centurion, commented: "I am delighted to add Renault to the growing list of motor manufacturers with whom Centurion is currently working. The joint venture with our strategic partner has enabled us to successfully design and manufacture a bespoke in-car entertainment system for Renault from scratch. We have received the first orders and following the success of this exciting new project, we are exploring the transferability of the core technology."
